#### Responsibilities

- · Serve as the primary instructor and leader for the front ensemble section.
- Develop and implement technique program, warm-ups, and sectional curriculum.
- Collaborate closely with design staff and ensemble directors to achieve performance goals.
- Manage and mentor front ensemble staff/techs to ensure instructional consistency.
- Provide feedback and adjustments to students both individually and as a section.
- Assist in managing equipment, electronics, and amplification setup.
